Dear Eagle Parents/Guardians,

The Colonel Crawford High School continues to be committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that we have recently received information regarding another confirmed student case of COVID-19 at CCHS. We have also had two other positive student cases at Colonel Crawford High School in the past two weeks.

Colonel Crawford High School (**Grades 9-12 Only**) will now **transition to remote learning** beginning, **Thursday, November 19th, 2020**, through Thanksgiving Break (November 25th). Information on remote classroom procedures, including Google Meets, was passed out to students last week at school. We are working closely with the Crawford County Health District, and anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by the health district/school district as a part of the COVID-19 protocol. We plan on resuming five days a week in-person education starting Tuesday, December 1st, 2020, as long as conditions are favorable.

High School students will attend in person on Wednesday, November 18th where they will receive final instructions for remote learning. This will give them a day to gather books and items from lockers. Busses will continue to run and students who attend Pioneer will continue to report as normal. Athletic practices will also proceed as scheduled. Please note that this remote plan is for High School (9-12) only. At this point, grades K-8 will continue to attend five days per week in person. If you have any other questions, please don't hesitate to call.

How you can help with COVID-19

Be proactive about reducing the number of interactions that students and staff have with one another by practicing social distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart) to limit the spread of COVID-19. In addition to physical distancing, these important tools help to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Wear a mask or face covering while in public places or if people who don't live with you must visit your home.
- Avoid unnecessary gatherings with people who don't live in your home.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and wash your hands immediately.
- Regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes
