

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are thankful to have made it these last two weeks in person with students. However, as you know, it is hard to say what is to come in 2021. That being said, I am including information to try to help us all be prepared and on the same page regardless of what schooling looks like after Christmas break.

Essentially, there are three possibilities. However, we also heard the feedback from you and the students after our eight days of remote learning, and we have made some adjustments to hopefully make it a little easier on everyone... if that's possible....hopefully. **AT THIS TIME, PLAN ON RETURNING FROM BREAK IN-PERSON FULL TIME.**

Option 1- FULL IN PERSON- We come back to Semester 2 in person. We all know this routine well. It works.

Option 2- MODIFIED REMOTE- this is the 2 days in person and 3 days remote plan. I am reattaching the list for your child's grade level specifying which students would come M/T and which would be Th/F. Lessons on remote days would be posted and students would be able to email and message teachers with questions that could not wait until they saw them. It would be different, but hopefully we could get into a good routine.

Option 3- FULLY REMOTE- this is what we did before & after Thanksgiving break. However, we think we can do better with the Google Meet schedule in order to simplify things. Things would be very much the same as before, but the following adjustments would be made.

- **Due Dates-**

- Teachers set their own due dates- work might be due daily or weekly based on the assignment or the teacher.

- **Google Meets-**

- On these days, they would go through their regular bell schedule, beginning with 1st period at 7:30 and check in with each teacher at the beginning of each class every day, periods 1-9. Obviously, they would not have to check in for study hall. However, special education /504 students would have their additional time to help between 11:07- 11:37 & 12:10-12:37 each day.
- Students would be required to attend ALL CLASSES.
- It might be the teacher presenting, going over information, answering questions, or simply having them "check in" to make sure they were doing ok with the work.
- If a student fails to report for a Google Meet, they would be absent. This is the same as before.
- (1 Missed Meet = ½ day absence)
- (2+ Missed Meets = 1 full day absence)
- Just like last time, if they can not make a meeting, they must contact the teacher with the reason as to why before the meet is to begin. If students are sick, have appointments, funerals etc please call the office 419-562-4666 that day and send a note when we return in person.
- If they are kicked out of the meets due to Internet issues, they must immediately contact their teacher.
- Students need to show their face during class time, be dressed appropriately, and be able to respond to questions. If their camera doesn't work they need to chat with the teacher the entire time in the chat, explaining, asking questions, and showing they are involved.
- Students need to be present for the entire meet time in order to receive credit.
- Mrs. Durham, Mrs. Ehman, and Mr. Foy will provide an additional opportunity for their students to get help each day from 11:07- 11:37 & 12:10-12:37 each day
